Wireless router and VoIP DECT handset

What is it?

- > Fixed line Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) telephone worth R3000 that offers savings of up to 50% on your telephone bill and money back when people call you. It is also a wireless VoIP router that replaces any modem/router that you currently have.

Is it for me?

- > If you spend more than R250/month on your phone bill, then the Vox ADSL Phone is for you!

What can I save?

- > An ADSL line. The phone is compatible with all Telkom ADSL lines, from 384Kbps to 4Mbps.
